The Bear River Band of the Rohnerville Rancheria is continually monitoring updates on COVID-19 from The Centers for Disease Control (CDC), The World Health Organization (WHO), The National Institutes of Health (NIH), as well as Local, State, and Federal Governments. Based on current guidance from these agencies, we have decided to suspend operations at Tish Non Community Center, Bear River Recreation Center and Family Entertainment Center. The Tobacco Traders will remain open as drive thru only.

Operations for these units will be suspended beginning at the end of business hours on Monday, March 16th. This closure will continue in effect for a minimum of one week and will be reevaluated for duration, as necessary. In an effort to continue to serve our Tribal Community and local community by offering some basic necessities, we will continue to operate our Pump and Play Gas Station and Convenience Store.

The Tribe is concerned, first and foremost, for the health and safety of its Tribal Members, employees and surrounding community members.
